**WAMI WINNER SCOTT E. BERENDT & THE US PROJECT TO PERFORM
AT FOURTH OF JULY COMMUNITY BASH**

HALES CORNERS, Wis., (June 2, 2015) – Scott E. Berendt & the US Project will headline the Friends of Hales Corners Park & Pool Community Bash on Saturday, July 4, from 6 to 9 p.m. and 10 to 11 p.m. in front of Pool House. The award-winning WAMI artist is collaborating with the US Project to bring an eclectic style often described as “world beat rock” with edgy vocals.

Berendt is a front-of-the-stage drummer and singer/songwriter who has opened for Collective Soul, Eddie Money, Everclear, O.A.R, BoDeans, Cheap Trick and dozens of other big bands. The band plays bits of jazz, Latin, swing/big band, blues, rock and reggae for a sound that could be compared to Sting, Seal, Dave Matthews, John Mayer, Peter Gabriel & Rusted Root.

The Community Bash starts at 4 p.m., and is located near the end of this year's parade route in front of the Pool House. In addition to Berendt, there will be food, beer and refreshments, plus a tent with plenty of seating and a dance floor. Residents can watch the end of the parade and party at the Bash before the fireworks at 9 p.m. The band will resume at 10 p.m., immediately following the fireworks and play until 11 p.m.

July 4th will be the final day to enter the Friends' drawing for a Tailgate Tub complete with an array of Packers liquor, beer and lemonade, a Weber Grill and grilling implements and other

Packers gear. The raffle entry is \$10 and all proceeds benefit the Friends and their efforts to maintain the pool and raise money for the sandpit volleyball court and the Alyson Dudek International Ice Center and Pavilion. The drawing will take place at the Community Bash at 7:30 p.m. Residents do not have to be in attendance to win.

There will also be a "Serve It Up" Volleyball Challenge for anyone interested in contributing to the sand volleyball court. Participants are asked to donate \$1 for each time they are able to volley the ball using their arms, hands, feet, head or any other aid before the ball hits the ground.
